SUBJECT: Assignment of Program Code "QS" to track Fiscal Year (FY) 2020/2021 Operation and Maintenance Funds Provided for the Coalition Readiness Support Program (CRSP), DSCA Policy 20-42 [SAMM E-Change 490]

Effective immediately, program code "QS" is assigned to track FY 2020/2021 Operation and Maintenance, Defense-wide funds appropriated under the Coalition Support Fund (CSF) and designated for the CRSP. CRSP is funded by CSF and appropriated under Division A of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020 (P.L. 116-93). CRSP funds will remain available for obligation until September 30, 2021. Activities under CRSP are authorized by Section 1233 of the FY 2008 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) (P.L. 110-181), as amended most recently by Section 1217 of the FY 2020 National Defense Authorization Act (P.L. 116-92).

Instructions for preparation of "QS" LOA documents are found in the SAMM, Table C15.T5. Standard notes applicable to BPC programs are found in the SAMM, Appendix 6, LOA Notes Listing. Funding associated with "QS" LOAs will be fully expended and "QS" cases will be reconciled and closed two months before the funds cancellation date. Management and execution of FY 2020/2021 "QS" programs must comply with guidance provided in the Security Assistance Management Manual (SAMM), Chapter 15.
